Passive: A delicious meal was cooked by the chef.

Passive: A letter is written by her every week.

Passive: The results will be announced by them tomorrow.

Passive: All the questions were answered by the students.
 5. My mother washes the clothes every day.
Passive: The clothes are washed by my mother every day.
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Part 2: Active to Passive Voice (Continuous Tenses)

Passive: A new bridge is being built by the workers.
