Passive: A new product will be launched by the company next month.

Passive: The results have been announced by the principal.

Passive: The wall is being painted by him right now.

Passive: The plants are watered by the gardener every morning.
7. They had completed the project before the deadline.
Passive: The project had been completed by them before the deadline.
